§94920 - Mandatory Cancellation, Withdrawal, and Refund Policies	<p>(b) Institutions shall refund 100 percent of the amount paid for institutional charges, less a reasonable deposit or application fee not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), if notice of cancellation is made through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh class day after enrollment, whichever is later.</p> <p>Institution's catalog shows non-refundable charges of \$100</p>




