19 1. On or about September 27, 2013, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education
20 (“Bureau”) received an Application for Approval to Operate an Institution Non-Accredited from
21 The Beauty World Cosmetology Academy USA (“Respondent”). On January 22, 2016, the
22 Bureau sent Respondent a Notice of Denial of Application for Approval to Operate. On March
23 12, 2016, Respondent submitted to the Bureau a letter requesting an administrative hearing.


24 2. On or about June 23, 2016, Joanne Wenzel, Chief of the Bureau for Private
25 Postsecondary Education, solely in her official capacity, filed Statement of Issues No. 1001582.

26 3. The basis for withdrawing the pending Statement of Issues No. 1001582 is that, on
27 July 20, 2016, the Bureau’s counsel received, via U.S. Mail, Respondent’s Notice of Withdrawal
