# 1. Amend section 70000 of Article 1, of Chapter 1, of Division 7.5, of Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations

#### 70000. Provisions

(\* \* \* \*)

- (i) "Degree program" means an educational program leading to the award of an academic degree as defined in section 94830 of the Code.
- (j) "Digital signature" means a signature made pursuant to Government Code section 16.5.
- (j) (k) "Duly qualified faculty" or "faculty member" means a person or people who satisfy the requirements of section 71720.

(aed) "Unit" or "unit of credit" means a measure of college or university level instruction that is evaluated by duly qualified faculty.

### 71380. Signatures and Certification.

- (2) If the institution is incorporated, by the chief executive officer <u>or president</u> of the corporation and each person who owns or controls 25 percent or more of the stock or interest in the institution, or
- (3) By each member of the governing body of a nonprofit corporation. If the institution is a nonprofit corporation or a public institution, by the chief executive officer or president.

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# 4. Amend Section 71390, of Article 2, of Chapter 2, of Division 7.5 of Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations

(a) An applicant seeking approval to operate by means of its accreditation pursuant to Section 94890(a)(1) of the Code shall complete the "Application for Approval to Operate for an Accredited Institution," Form Application 94890 (rev. 2/108/24).

- (d) The application shall be signed <u>with original or digital signature</u> and dated, and each fact stated therein and each attachment thereto shall be declared to be true under penalty of perjury, as follows:

- (C) Each member of the governing body of a nonprofit corporation. If the institution is a nonprofit corporation or a public institution, by the chief executive officer or president.

### 71395. Application; Fees.

(a) In order to obtain verification from the Bureau that it is exempt pursuant to Section 94874 of the Code, an institution must complete "Application for Verification of Exempt Status," Form Application 94874 (rev. 2/108/24).

### 71396. Application Form; Immediate STRF Compliance.

(a) An applicant seeking to operate an out-of-state private postsecondary institution, as defined in Section 94850.5 of the Code, that is required to register with the Bureau

pursuant to Section 94801.5 of the Code, shall complete the Bureau's Application for Registration or Re-Registration of Out-of-State Institution [Form Application 94801.5 (rev. 8/224)], which is hereby incorporated by reference. An applicant shall submit to the Bureau the completed form, the information and documentation required by Section 94801.5 of the Code, and the registration fee as provided in Section 94930.5 of the Code.

### 71475. Renewal of an Approval to Operate for a Non-Accredited Institution; Cancellation of an Approval to Operate

- (b) An institution seeking to renew its Approval to Operate pursuant to section 94891 of the Code shall, prior to its expiration, complete and submit to the Bureau the "Application for Renewal of Approval to Operate and Offer Educations Programs for Non-Accredited Institutions," Form Application 94891 (rev. 2/108/24).

- (B) If the institution is incorporated, by the chief executive officer <u>or president</u> of the corporation\_and each person who owns or controls 25 percent or more of the stock or interest in the institution, or
- (C) Each member of the governing body of a nonprofit corporation. If the institution is a nonprofit corporation or a public institution, by the chief executive officer or president.

case it shall be submitted no later than 30 <u>calendar</u> days following the change in location. The form shall be submitted to the Bureau along with the appropriate fee as provided in Section 94930.5(c) of the Code. It shall be signed by the signatory(ies) required by section 71380 and dated, and each fact stated therein and each attachment thereto shall be declared to be true under penalty of perjury, in the following form:

The form shall be submitted to the Bureau along with the appropriate fee as provided in Section 94930.5(c) of the Code.

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14. Amend Section 71652, of Article 7, of Chapter 2, of Division 7.5 of Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations

71652. Application for a Change to Begin Participation in Federal Student Financial Aid Programs Authorized by Title IV of the Federal Higher Education Act of 1965, as Amended (20 U.S.C. Sec. 1070 et seq.)

(a) An institution seeking to begin participation in federal Student Financial Aid Programs authorized by Title IV of the federal Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended (20 U.S.C. Sec. 1070 et seq. – federal Higher Education Act of 1965) shall complete the "Application for Authorization for Institution to Begin Participation in Student Financial Aid Programs (Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965)" form (AID New. 8/2224) which is hereby incorporated by reference, to obtain prior authorization from the Bureau in accordance with 94894 of the Code. The form shall be submitted to the Bureau along with the appropriate fee for authorization of a substantive change as provided in Section 94930.5(c) of the Code.

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15. Amend Section 71653, of Article 7, of Chapter 2, of Division 7.5 of Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations

71653. Application for Authorization for a Change in Academic Measurement of an Educational Program from Clock Hours to Credit Hours

(a) An institution seeking to change the academic measurement of an educational program from clock hours to credit hours shall complete the "Application for Authorization to Change from Clock Hours to Credit Hours" form (CREDIT New. 8/2224) which is hereby incorporated by reference, to obtain prior authorization from the Bureau in accordance with 94894 of the Code. The form shall be submitted to the Bureau along with the appropriate fee for authorization of a substantive change as provided in Section 94930.5(c) of the Code.

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### Application for Registration or Re-Registration of Out of State Institutions

(California Education Code §§ 94801.5, 94850.5, 94930.5; Title 5, California Code of Regulations §§ 71396, 74000, 76130, 76215) (\$1,500.00 fee to register and re-register)

Effective July 1, 2017, an out-of-state private postsecondary educational institution must register with the Bureau or is not authorized to enroll California students. (Ed. Code § 94801.5.) "Out-of-state private postsecondary educational institution" means a private entity without a physical presence in California that offers postsecondary distance education to California students for a fee, regardless of whether the entity has any affiliates located in California. (Ed. Code § 94850.5.) Non-public higher education institutions that are degree granting, non-profit, and accredited are exempt and need not register. (Ed. Code § 94801.5(c).) Each registration and re-registration application carries a nonrefundable fee of \$1,500.00. An approved registration is valid for five years. (Ed. Code § 94930.5(e)(1), 94801.5(e).)

To be eligible to register (or for re-registration after expiration of a prior registration), the \$1,500 fee and any applicable documentation identified below must be included with the information required in this application.
