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#### **Definitions**

- "On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.

- "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "Graduates Available for Employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.
- "Graduates Unavailable for Employment" means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are
  called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing
  employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved
  postsecondary institution.
- "Graduates Employed in the Field" means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.

#### STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

#### Cancellations, Withdrawals, and Refunds

- (a) An institution that participates in the federal student financial aid programs complies with this article by complying with applicable regulations of the federal student financial aid programs under Title IV of the federal Higher Education Act of 1965.
- (b) The institution shall advise each student that a notice of cancellation shall be in writing, and that a withdrawal may be effectuated by the student's written notice or by the student's conduct, including, but not necessarily limited to, a student's lack of attendance.
- (c) The institution shall also provide a pro rata refund of nonfederal student financial aid program moneys paid for institutional charges to students who have completed 60 percent or less of the period of attendance.
- (d) Institutions shall refund 100 percent of the amount paid for institutional charges, less a reasonable deposit or application fee not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), if notice of cancellation is made through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later.

Student will be notified of approval by admissions within 3 business days, to proceed with Cancellation or Withdrawal procedures. Admissions will contact student via phone call and/o mail to confirm cancellation or withdrawal process is complete. If student mails a written cancellation/withdrawal notice, he/she will be notified within 5-7 business days by admissions to confirm process is complete. "If you cancel, any payment you have made and any negotiable instrument signed by you shall be returned to you within 45 days following the school's receipt of your cancellation notice. But, if the school gave you any equipment, you must return the equipment within 45 days of the date you signed a cancellation notice. If you do not return the equipment within this 45-day period, the school may keep an amount out of what you paid that equals the cost of the equipment. The total amount charged for each item of equipment shall be separately stated. The amount charged for each item of equipment shall not exceed the equipment's fair market value. The institution shall have the burden of proof to establish the equipment's fair market value.
