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This program is new. - "On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).
- "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "Graduates Available for Employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.
- "Graduates Unavailable for Employment" means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.
- "Graduates Employed in the Field" means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- "Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- "Number of Graduates Taking Exam" is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.
- "First Available Exam Date" is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.
- "Passage Rate" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.



• "Number Who Passed First Available Exam" is the number of graduates who took and passed the first

	available licensing exam after completing the program.
•	"Salary" is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.

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#### **STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL**

A student may withdraw from the seminary at any time by completing the necessary paperwork through the Registrar's office. A student cannot assume that a class is dropped simply by not attending.

Students who withdraw <u>before the start of a term</u> will be refunded any tuition paid. However, registration fees and application fees are non-refundable.

Students who withdraw <u>after the start of a term but before 50% of a course is completed</u> will receive refunds based on the following:

- When a student drops a class after the first day of the term, the student must pay for contact hours attended (or even those not attended if the student fails to notify the Registrar's office). The student will receive a refund or adjustment to his/her account. At the current rates, tuition is \$24 per contact hour. Fees are nonrefundable.
- For Internet courses, the professor will verify the last date of attendance to calculate contact hours in the course in order to arrive at the amount of refund or adjustment.
- At Central Baptist Theological Seminary, 1 credit is the equivalent of 15 contact hours.

Students who withdraw <u>after the start of a term but after 50% of a course is completed</u> will not receive any refund.
