1. - 2. Cancellation may occur when the student provides a written notice of cancellation at the following address: NAME OF SCHOOL AND ADDRESS. This can be done by mail or by hand delivery.
- 3. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with proper postage.
