- "Passage Rate" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.
- "Number Who Passed First Available Exam" is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.
- "Salary" is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.
- "No Salary Information Reported" is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.



STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

1.	You have the right to cancel your agreement for a program of instruction, without any penalty or obligations, through
	attendance at the first-class session or the seventh calendar day after enrollment, whichever is later. After the end of the
	cancellation period, you also have the right to stop school at any time; and you have the right to receive a pro rata refund if
	you have completed 60 percent or less of the scheduled hours in the current payment period in your program through the
	last day of attendance.
	Cancellation of this agreement can occur up to:

- 2. Cancellation may occur when the student provides a written notice of cancellation at the following address: 1765 Challenge Way Sacramento, CA 95815. This can be done by mail or by hand delivery.
- 3. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with proper postage.
- 4. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and, however expressed, it is effective if it shows that the student no longer wishes to be bound by the Enrollment Agreement.
- 5. If the Enrollment Agreement is cancelled prior to the cancellation period the school will refund the student any money he/she paid, less a application and registration fee of \$200.00, and less any deduction for uniforms not returned, within 7 days after the notice of cancellation is received.
