23	PARTIES 1. Dr. Michael Marion, Jr. (Complainant) brings this Accusation solely in his official	
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25	capacity as the Chief of the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau), Department of Consumer Affairs.	
26 27	2. On or about January 4, 1999, the Bureau issued Approval to Operate a Non-	
28	Accredited Institution Number 1937251 to Edison Truck and Bus Driving School, Inc., Edison D.	
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(EDISON TRUCK AND BUS DRIVING SCHOOL, INC., EDISON D. FREIRE, TONNIE P. FREIRE, MIRELLA C. FREIRE) ACCUSATION

Freire, Tonnie P. Freire, Mirella C. Freire (Respondent). On or about May 28, 2013, the Bureau received an application for Renewal of Approval to Operate a Non-Accredited Institution from Edison Truck and Bus Driving School, Inc., (Respondent). The Bureau denied the application on February 7, 2017.

JURISDICTION

- 3. This Accusation is brought before the Director of the Department of Consumer Affairs (Director) for the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education, under the authority of the following laws. All section references are to the Education Code unless otherwise indicated.
 - 4. Section 118 of the Bus. & Prof. Code states in pertinent part:

"…

- (b) The suspension, expiration, or forfeiture by operation of law of a license issued by a board in the department, or its suspension, forfeiture, or cancellation by order of the board or by order of a court of law, or its surrender without the written consent of the board, shall not, during any period in which it may be renewed, restored, reissued, or reinstated, deprive the board of its authority to institute or continue a disciplinary proceeding against the licensee upon any ground provided by law or to enter an order suspending or revoking the license or otherwise taking disciplinary action against the licensee on any such ground.
- (c) As used in this section, >board= includes an individual who is authorized by any provision of this code to issue, suspend, or revoke a license, and 'license' includes 'certificate,' 'registration,' and 'permit.'"
 - 5. Section 477 of the Bus. & Prof. Code states:
 - "As used in this division:
- (a) 'Board' includes 'bureau,' 'commission,' 'committee,' 'department,' 'division,' 'examining committee,' 'program,' and 'agency.'
- (b) 'License' includes certificate, registration or other means to engage in a business or profession regulated by this code."
 - 6. Section 94932 of the Code states:

"The bureau shall determine an institution's compliance with the requirements of this chapter. The bureau shall have the power to require reports that institutions shall file with the bureau in addition to the annual report, to send staff to an institution's sites, and to require documents and responses from an institution to monitor compliance. When the bureau has reason to believe that an institution may be out of compliance, it shall conduct an investigation of the institution. If the bureau determines, after completing an investigation, that an institution has violated any applicable law or regulation, the bureau shall take appropriate action pursuant to this article."

STATUTORY AND REGULATORY PROVISIONS

7. Section 94897 of the Code states:

- (j) In any manner make an untrue or misleading change in, or untrue or misleading statement related to, a test score, grade or record of grades, attendance record, record indicating student completion, placement, employment, salaries, or financial information, including any of the following:
 - (1) A financial report filed with the bureau."
 - 8. Cal. Code of Regs., Title 5 section 76120 states:
- "(a) Each qualifying institution shall collect an assessment of zero dollars (\$0) per one thousand dollars (\$1,000) of institutional charges, rounded to the nearest thousand dollars, from each student in an educational program who is a California resident or is enrolled in a residency program. For institutional charges of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or less, the assessment is zero dollars (\$0)."1

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¹ Effective January 1, 2015, the Student Tuition Recovery Fund (STRF) assessment rate was changed to zero and schools were to no longer collect STRF assessments pursuant to this provision.

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³ Review of enrollment agreements for P.A., J.L. and G.G. all demonstrated that the students were all unlawfully charged STRF fees.

SECOND CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(Filing False or Misleading Financial Report)

15. Respondent is subject to disciplinary action pursuant to Code section 94897 subdivision (j)(1) in that Respondent filed a false and misleading financial report. Complainant refers to and incorporates paragraphs 9 – 13 above, as if fully set forth herein.

PRAYER

WHEREFORE, Complainant requests that a hearing be held on the matters herein alleged, and that following the hearing, the Director of the Department of Consumer Affairs issue a decision:

- Revoking or suspending Revocation of Approval to Operate a Non-Accredited
 Institution Number 1937251, issued to Edison Truck and Bus Driving School, Inc., Edison D.
 Freire, Tonnie P. Freire, Mirella C. Freire;
- 2. Ordering Respondent to pay the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of this case, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 125.3; and,
 - 3. Taking such other and further action as deemed necessary and proper.
