On or about January 26, 2018, Dr. Michael Marion, Jr., Chief of the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education, Department of Consumer Affairs, filed Statement of Issues No. 1002980 solely in his official capacity. The Bureau subsequently amended the Statement of Issues. The current pleading is the Third Amended Statement of Issues No. 1002980. After initiating this action, Respondent provided additional documents and information intended to resolve the issues of non-compliance in Respondent's application.
