On December 20, 2019, an informal telephone conference was held in the matter of Citation: Assessment of Fine and Order of Abatement No. 1920140 (Citation) against Amarillo College of Hairdressing, Inc., DBA Milan Institute, Owner of Milan Institute (Institution). In attendance were Leeza Rifredi, Deputy Bureau Chief and Dr. Marcy Ceranek, Director of Compliance and Career Services Technology Director.

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code, section 125.9; California Education Code, section 94936; and Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations, section 75020 and section 75040, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) renders the following decision relative to your appeal of the Citation No. 1920140.

It is the decision of the Deputy Bureau Chief that on January 15, 2020, Citation No. 1920140 is modified and makes the following change(s):

CEC Section 94929.5 - Reporting of Student Performance Data

- (a) An institution shall annually report to the bureau, as part of the annual report, and shall publish in its School Performance Fact Sheet, all of the following:
- (2) The license examination passage rates for the immediately preceding two years for programs leading to employment for which passage of a state licensing examination is required, calculated by dividing the number of graduates who pass the examination by the number of graduates who take the licensing examination the first time that the examination is available after completion of the educational program. The institution shall use state agency licensing data to calculate license examination passage rates. If those data are unavailable, the institution shall calculate the license examination passage rate in a manner consistent with regulations adopted by the bureau.

The Institution's 2016-2017 School Performance Fact Sheets (SPFS) for the Registered Dental Assistant Program failed to report Licensing Examination Passage Rate Information.

Order of Abatement:

The Bureau orders the Institution to submit the missing data on the 2016-2017 SPFS and a written policy of how future compliance with CEC Section 94929.5 will be maintained.

<u>Reason for modification</u>: New substantive facts were presented at the conference. The Order of Abatement has been satisfied.

Assessment of Fine

The fine for this violation is \$2.500.00.

The administrative fine for this violation has been modified from \$2,500.00 to \$250.00.
