Christina Villanueva issues this Citation: Assessment of Fine and Order of Abatement (Citation) in her official capacity as Discipline Manager of the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) of the California Department of Consumer Affairs.

### **CITATION**

A Citation is hereby issued to California Southern University, Owner of California Southern University (Institution) located at 3330 Harbor Boulevard, Costa Mesa, CA 92626, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 125.9; California Education Code (CEC) sections 94936 and 94932; and Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations (5, CCR) section 75020 for the violations described below.

### BACKGROUND

On October 29, 2019, Bureau staff conducted an unannounced Compliance inspection at the Institution. Upon inspection, the Bureau staff was informed that the Institution was unable to access the supporting documentation for the 2016-2017 School Performance Fact Sheet (SPFS) as well as the documentation for the 2019 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter Student Tuition Recovery Fund (STRF) Assessment Reporting Form

### VIOLATION

	The Institution stated they were unable to provide Bureau staff with the supporting documentation

to substantiate the data reported on the 2016-2017 SPFS, as well as the 2019 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter STRF Assessment Reporting Form. The Institution stated the supporting documents were stored on a shared drive that they were unable to access.

## Order of Abatement:

The Bureau orders the Institution to submit to the Bureau the supporting documentation to substantiate the data reported on the 2016-2017 SPFS, as well as the supporting documentation to substantiate the data reported on the 2019 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter STRF Assessment Reporting Form. In addition, the Bureau orders the Institution to submit a written policy, or procedure, of how future compliance will be maintained per 5 CCR Section 71930.

### Assessment of Fine

The fine for this violation is <u>\$1,500.00</u>

### ASSESSMENT OF A FINE

### **COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER OF ABATEMENT**

In accordance with the provisions of CEC section 94936 and 5, CCR section 75020 the Bureau hereby issues the order(s) of abatement described above. **Evidence of compliance with the order(s) of abatement must be submitted, to the Bureau, within <u>30 days</u> from the date of service of the Citation.** 

### APPEAL OF CITATION

You have the right to contest this Citation through an informal conference with the Bureau; and/or through an administrative hearing in accordance with Chapter 5 (Commencing with Section 11500) of Part 1 of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code.

If you wish to contest this Citation, you must submit the 'Notice of Appeal of Citation – Request for Informal Conference and/or Administrative Hearing' form (enclosed) within <u>30 days</u> from the date of service of the Citation. *If you do not request an informal conference and/or an administrative hearing within 30 days from the service of the Citation, you will not be able to request one at a later time.* 

Unless a written request for an informal conference and/or an administrative hearing is signed by you and delivered to the Bureau by **July 31, 2020**, you will be deemed to have waived or forfeited your right to appeal this matter.

#### **EFFECTIVE DATE OF CITATION**

If you do not request an informal conference and/or an administrative hearing, this Citation shall become effective on **July 1, 2020**. Payment of the administrative fine and evidence of compliance with the order(s) of abatement shall be due by **July 31, 2020**. Your payment of the administrative fine shall not constitute an admission of the violation(s) charged.

If a hearing is requested, you will not be required to comply with this Citation until 30 days after a final order is entered against you.
