On September 10, 2020, an informal telephone conference was held in the matter of Citation: Assessment of Fine and Order of Abatement No. 2021044 (Citation) against Amarillo College of Hairdressing, Inc., Owner of Milan Institute of Cosmetology (Institution). In attendance were Beth Scott, Enforcement Chief and Marcy Ceranek, Director of Compliance and Career Services Technology Director.

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code, section 125.9; California Education Code, section 94936; and Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations, section 75020 and section 75040, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) renders the following decision relative to your appeal of the Citation No. 2021044.

It is the decision of the Enforcement Chief that on October 1, 2020, Citation No. 2021044 is affirmed for the following reason(s):

- No new substantive facts were presented at the conference.

VIOLATION CODE SECTIONS

1.	<p>5, CCR Section 74006(a) and (b) - Annual Fee <i>“(a) An institution's annual fee is due within 30 days of the date on which the institution originally receives its approval to operate and each year thereafter on the anniversary of the date of the original approval. (b) An institution shall pay its annual fee in addition to any other applicable fees.”</i></p> <p>CEC Section 94930.5 (d)(1)(B)- Fee Schedule <i>“(d) (1) In addition to any fees paid to the bureau pursuant to subdivisions (a) to (c), inclusive, each institution that is approved to operate pursuant to this chapter shall remit both of the following:</i></p>



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(B) An annual campus fee for each branch of the institution in an amount equal to 0.45 percent of the branch’s total gross revenue derived from students in California, but not to be less than two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) and not to exceed sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000)."

CEC Section 94931(a) -Late Payment

"(a) A fee that is not paid on or before the 30th calendar day after the due date for the payment of the fee shall be subject to 25 percent late payment penalty fee."

The Institution has failed to pay its late payment penalty fee for calendar year 2017.

On April 14, 2017, the Institution was notified Invoice # 900320600 via mail at, 2345 W. Beech Avenue, Suite 4139, Visalia, CA 93277, stating that the annual fee for calendar year 2017 was due on May 1, 2017.

On June 7, 2017, the Bureau received the annual fee for calendar year 2017 in the amount of \$2,746.72.

On June 15, 2017, the Institution was notified Invoice # 900322353 via mail at, Corporate Compliance Department 1720, W. Walnut Avenue, Visalia, CA 93277, stating that the annual fee for calendar year 2017 was due on May 1, 2017.

On July 3, 2017, the Institution was notified that a balance of \$686.68 for the 25% late fee was due as the annual fee payment was received after May 31, 2017.

As of August 5, 2020, the Bureau has not received the payment for the late payment penalty fee from the Institution.

Order of Abatement:

The Bureau orders the Institution to submit its late payment penalty fee per CEC Section 94931 (a).

The Bureau will promptly take all appropriate action to enforce the Affirmed Citation and recover the civil penalties prescribed therein or found to be due after a hearing.
