The Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) issues this Notice to Comply pursuant to California Education Code (CEC) section 94935 and Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations (5 CCR) section 75010.

Violation	Code Section Violated	Description of the violation and required correction.
1	CEC § 94909 (a)(3)(D)	 Violation Description: The institution's 2025 catalog, failed to contain the required verbatim statement: "The Office of Student Assistance and Relief is available to support prospective students, current students, or past students of private postsecondary educational institutions in making informed decisions, understanding their rights, and navigating available services and relief options. The office may be reached by calling (888) 370-7589 or by visiting www.bppe.ca.gov." Correction: The institution shall update the catalog, to include the above-mentioned statement, pursuant to
		CEC § 94909 (a)(3)(D).
2	5 CCR § 71810 (b)(3)	Violation Description: According to page 24 of the institution's 2025 catalog, the institution offers services for international students, however the catalog failed to identify whether visa services are provided or whether the institution will vouch for student status, and any associated charges.

Violation	Code Section Violated	Description of the violation and required correction.
		Correction: The institution shall update its catalog to identify whether visa services are provided or whether the institution will vouch for student status, and any associated charges, pursuant to 5 CCR § 71810 (b)(3).
3	CEC § 94909 (a)(5)	Violation Description: On page 64 of the institution's 2025 catalog identifies a total of 176 hours is required to complete the Nurse Assistant Training Program. However, according to Bureau records 190 hours is required to complete the Nurse Assistant Training Program.
		Correction: The institution shall either provide proof of the documentation submitted to the Bureau's Licensing Unit for the approval to update the total number of hours required for completion for the Nurse Assistant Training Program to 176 hours.
		If the institution did not notify Bureau's Licensing Unit of the change, the institution must contact the Bureau's Licensing Unit at <u>BPPE.Licensing@dca.ca.gov</u> regarding information and requirements to update the Bureau's records.
		Otherwise, if the Bureau's records are correct the institution shall update the catalog to reflect the total number of clock hours required to complete the Nurse Assistant Training Program, in accordance with the Bureau's records, pursuant to CEC § 94909 (a)(5).
4	CEC § 94909 (a)(14) in conjunction with 5 CCR § 76215 (b)	Violation Description: Although pages 50-52 of the institution's 2025 contains the required STRF statement, the statement on page 51 references the Bureau's old address (2535 Capitol Oaks Drive, Suite 400, Sacramento, CA 95833) and old telephone number (916-431-6959).
		Correction: The institution shall update the STRF disclosure in the institution's catalog with the Bureau's current address (1747 North Market Blvd., Suite 225, Sacramento, California, 95834) and current telephone number (916-574-8900), pursuant to CEC § 94909 (a)(14) and 5 CCR § 76215 (b).

5	CEC § 94909 (a)(10)	 Violation Description: Although the institution's 2025 catalog contains information for federal financial aid programs, the institution failed to include a statement reporting whether the institution participates in state financial aid programs. Correction: The institution shall update its catalog to include the above-mentioned information, pursuant to
		CEC § 94909 (a)(10).
6	5 CCR § 71810 (b)(6)	Violation Description: The institution's 2025 catalog failed to identify the institution's policies and practices regarding any form of financial aid, Veterans Affairs benefits, including all consumer information which the institution is required to disclose to the student under any state or federal financial aid program. The institution's Vocational Nursing 2025 curriculum guide/brochure includes information regarding Veterans Affairs (VA) benefits that is not described in the institution's 2025 catalog.
		Correction: The institution shall update its catalog to include information regarding the institution's policies and practices regarding any form of financial aid including the Veterans Affairs (VA) benefits described in the institution's advertisement, pursuant to 5 CCR § 71810 (b)(6).
7	5 CCR § 71810 (b)(15) in conjunction with CEC § 94897 (s)	Violation Description: Page 52 of the institution's 2025 catalog contains an unenforceable policy that states, "Angeles Institute reserves the right to withhold a student's transcript or any other documentation for hours completed but not yet paid for." In accordance with CEC § 94897 (s) and Civil Code section 1788.93, an institution cannot require a student to satisfy financial obligations or make arrangements for payment prior to providing a transcript to a student.
		Correction: The institution shall remove the non- compliant statement from the catalog. The institution's policy must demonstrate compliance with 5 CCR 71810 (b)(15) and CEC § 94897 (s).

8	5 CCR § 71800 (b)	Violation Description: The institution's enrollment agreements, failed to identify the period covered by the enrollment agreement.	
		Correction: The institution shall update all enrollment agreements to identify the period covered by the enrollment agreement, pursuant to 5 CCR § 71800 (b).	
9	5 CCR § 76215 (a)	Violation Description: On page 3 of the nurse assistant training program enrollment agreement, the Student Tuition Recovery Fund (STRF) disclosure is missing the last sentence of the verbatim disclosure.	
		Correction: The institution shall update the STRF disclosure in the institution's nurse assistant training program enrollment agreement to include all parts of the verbatim statement, pursuant to 5 CCR § 76215 (a).	
10	CEC § 94913 (a)(1)	Violation Description: The institution's website contains a catalog with violations identified in this NTC.	
		Correction: Once the institution's catalog has been updated to remedy the violation(s), the institution shall update its website to provide the current/updated institution catalog pursuant to CEC § 94913(a)(1).	
11	CEC § 94913 (a)(2)	Violation Description: The institution failed to post on its website, a link to the institution's 2022-2023 School Performance Fact Sheets.	
		Correction: The institution shall update its website to include a link to the institution's 2022-2023 School Performance Fact Sheets, pursuant to CEC § 94913 (a)(2).	
12	CEC § 94913 (a)(5)	Violation Description: The institution failed to post on its website, a link to the institution's most recent annual report submitted to the Bureau. According to Bureau records, the most recent annual report submitted is the <u>2023 Annual Report</u> .	
		Correction: The institution shall update its website to include a link to the institution's 2023 Annual Report, pursuant to CEC § 94913 (a)(5).	

Violation	Code Section Violated	Description of the violation and required correction.
13	CEC § 94897 (I)	 Violation Description: Throughout the institution's website (homepage and program pages) under the Accreditations and Approvals section, the institution identifies it was granted institutional approval to operate by the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education, however the institution failed to define the term approval to operate. Correction: The institution shall update the statements on its website, where the institution identifies it was granted approval to operate by the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education to state, "BPPE APPROVED - Approval to Operate means compliance with state standards as set forth in the California Private Postsecondary Education Act of 2009".

Pursuant to 5 CCR section 75010(d), the Institution may do either of the following:

(1) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, sign and return the notice to comply, declaring under penalty of perjury that the violation was corrected and describing how compliance was achieved; or

(2) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, file with the Bureau a written notice of disagreement, specifying the minor violations described in the notice to comply with which the person approved to operate the institution disagrees, and appealing it by requesting an informal office conference. If a written notice of disagreement is not timely filed with the Bureau, the right to appeal is deemed to have been waived.

Pursuant to CEC section 94935(h), failure to comply with the notice to comply will result in the Bureau taking appropriate administrative enforcement action.

The Notice to Comply was given to the Institution's owner, person in control, chief academic officer, chief executive officer, chief operating officer, institution director, or any person delegated by any of the aforementioned persons to facilitate the inspection or accept such notice as set forth below.
