1	CEC § 94909 (a)(3)(D)	Violation Description: The institution's 2025 catalog, failed to contain the required verbatim statement: "The Office of Student Assistance and Relief is available to support prospective students, current students, or past students of private postsecondary educational institutions in making informed decisions, understanding their rights, and navigating available services and relief options. 11	CEC § 94911 (j)(1)	Violation Description: Although page 6 of the institution's enrollment agreement contains the required statement, the statement reference the Bureau's old address (2535 Capitol Oaks Drive, Suite 400, Sacramento, CA 95833).
		Correction: The institution shall update the statement in the enrollment agreement with the Bureau's current address (1747 North Market Blvd., Suite 225, Sacramento, California, 95834), pursuant to CEC § 94911 (j)(1).
12	CEC § 94911 (i)(1)	<b>Violation Description:</b> The statement on page 5 of the institution's enrollment agreement is not verbatim and is missing part if the required statement.
		Correction: The institution shall update its current enrollment agreement with the required verbatim disclosure, pursuant to CEC § 94911 (i)(1).

15	CEC § 94913 (a)(1)	Violation Description: The institution's website contains a catalog with violations identified in this NTC.
		<b>Correction:</b> Once the institution's catalog has been updated to remedy the violation(s), the institution shall update its website to provide the current/updated institution catalog pursuant to CEC § 94913(a)(1).
16	5 CCR § 74117 in conjunction with CEC § 94913 (a)(4)	Violation Description: The institution's website ( <a href="https://www.ati.edu/">https://www.ati.edu/</a> ) failed to post on the homepage of its website clear and conspicuous link the bureau's internet website as required in Section 94913(a) of the Code.

Pursuant to 5 CCR section 75010(d), the Institution may do either of the following:

- (1) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, sign and return the notice to comply, declaring under penalty of perjury that the violation was corrected and describing how compliance was achieved; or
- (2) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, file with the Bureau a written notice of

disagreement, specifying the minor violations described in the notice to comply with which the person approved to operate the institution disagrees, and appealing it by requesting an informal office conference. If a written notice of disagreement is not timely filed with the Bureau, the right to appeal is deemed to have been waived.

## Pursuant to CEC section 94935(h), failure to comply with the notice to comply will result in the Bureau taking appropriate administrative enforcement action.
