Christina Villanueva issues this Citation: Assessment of Fine and Order of Abatement (Citation) in her official capacity as Discipline Manager of the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) of the California Department of Consumer Affairs.

CITATION

A Citation is hereby issued to Laguna Technical College, Owner of Laguna Technical College (Institution) located at 260 S. Garey Avenue, Pomona, CA 91766, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 125.9; California Education Code (CEC) sections 94936 and 94932; and Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations (5, CCR) section 75020 for the violations described below.

BACKGROUND

On April 15, 2021, Bureau staff conducted an unannounced Compliance inspection at the Institution. Bureau staff reviewed student files and found potential material violations related to Enrollment Agreements and School Performance Fact Sheets (SPFS).

VIOLATION(S)

1. Violation:

CEC Section 94902(a)(b)(3) - General Enrollment Requirements

- "(a) A student shall enroll solely by means of executing an enrollment agreement. The enrollment agreement shall be signed by the student and by an authorized employee of the institution.
- (b) An enrollment agreement is not enforceable unless all of the following requirements are met:
- (3) Prior to the execution of the enrollment agreement, the student and the institution have signed and dated the information required to be disclosed in the Student Performance Fact Sheet pursuant to subdivisions (a) to (d), inclusive, of Section 94910. Each of these items in the Student Performance Fact Sheet shall include a line for the student to initial and shall be initialed and dated by the student."

5, CCR Section 71800(c) - Enrollment Agreement

"In addition to the requirements of section 94911 of the Code, an institution shall provide to each student an enrollment agreement that contains at the least the following information: (c) Program start date and scheduled completion date."

Bureau staff reviewed student files and found enrollment agreements and SPFS that were not signed by a school representative. Bureau staff asked the Institution owner about the missing school representative signatures and they stated that Institution staff did not always sign the enrollment documents and that they thought that having students sign the enrollment documents was sufficient. Furthermore, Bureau staff found that the enrollment agreements did not include a start date and an end date for the program in which the students were enrolled in.

Order of Abatement:

The Bureau orders the Institution to submit a written policy, or procedure, of how the Institution will maintain future compliance with CEC Section 94902 and 5, CCR Section 71800.

Assessment of Fine

The fine for this violation is \$3,000.00

TOTAL ADMINISTRATIVE FINE DUE: \$3,000.00

ASSESSMENT OF A FINE

In accordance with CEC section 94936; and 5, CCR sections 75020 and 75030, the Bureau hereby orders this assessment of fine in the amount of \$3,000.00 for the violations described above. Payment must be made, to the Bureau, within 30 days from the date of service of the Citation.

COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER OF ABATEMENT

In accordance with the provisions of CEC section 94936 and 5, CCR section 75020 the Bureau hereby issues the order(s) of abatement described above. **Evidence of compliance with the order(s) of abatement must be submitted, to the Bureau, within 30 days** from the date of service of the Citation.

APPEAL OF CITATION

You have the right to contest this Citation through an informal conference with the Bureau; and/or through an administrative hearing in accordance with Chapter 5 (Commencing with Section 11500) of Part 1 of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code.

If you wish to contest this Citation, you must submit the 'Notice of Appeal of Citation – Request for Informal Conference and/or Administrative Hearing' form (enclosed) within 30 days from the date of service of the Citation. If you do not request an informal conference and/or an administrative hearing within 30 days from the service of the Citation, you will not be able to request one at a later time.

Unless a written request for an informal conference and/or an administrative hearing is signed by you and delivered to the Bureau by **September 18, 2021**, you will be deemed to have waived or forfeited your right to appeal this matter.

EFFECTIVE DATE OF CITATION

If you do not request an informal conference and/or an administrative hearing, this Citation shall become effective on **August 19, 2021**. Payment of the administrative fine and evidence of compliance with the order(s) of abatement shall be due by **September 18, 2021**. Your payment of the administrative fine shall not constitute an admission of the violation(s) charged.

If a hearing is requested, you will not be required to comply with this Citation until 30 days after a final order is entered against you.
