



# APPEAL OF CITATION INFORMAL CONFERENCE DECISION: CITATION MODIFIED

On Wednesday, October 30, 2019, an informal telephone conference was held in the matter of Citation: Assessment of Fine and Order of Abatement No. 1920112 (Citation) against Marin County Success Beauty Academy, LLC., Owner of Marin Success Beauty Academy (Institution). In attendance were Leeza Rifredi, Deputy Bureau Chief and Julius Lavares, Owner.

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code, section 125.9; California Education Code, section 94936; and Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations, section 75020 and section 75040, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) renders the following decision relative to your appeal of the Citation No. 1920112.

It is the decision of the Deputy Bureau Chief that on October 30, 2019, Citation No. 1920112 is <u>modified</u> and makes the following change(s):

## VIOLATION CODE SECTIONS

#	Below you will find the California Education Code (CEC) and/or Title 5 of the California
	Code of Regulations (5, CCR code) section(s) of law you are charged with violating.
1.	<u>Violation:</u>
	5, CCR Section 76130 (a-e)– Collection and Submission of Assessments
	(a) A qualifying institution shall collect the assessment from each student in an educational
	program at the time it collects the first payment from or on behalf of the student at or after
	enrollment. The assessment shall be collected for the entire period of enrollment, regardless of
	whether the student pays the institutional charges in increments.
	(b) A qualifying institution shall complete the STRF Assessment Reporting Form (Rev. 2/10) and
	remit it with the STRF assessments collected from students to be received by the Bureau no later
	than the last day of the month following the close of the quarter as follows:
	(1) April 30 for the first quarter,
	(2) July 31 for the second quarter,
	(3) October 31 for the third quarter, and

(4) January 31 for the fourth quarter. If the due date falls on a Saturday, Sunday or State or federal holiday, the due date shall be extended to the next regular business day for the Bureau.

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(c) The STRF Assessment Reporting Form shall contain the following information:

(1) Total number of students who signed enrollment agreements for educational programs during the reporting period; and

(2) Total number of students eligible for STRF who signed enrollment agreements for educational programs during the reporting period; and

(3) The total number of students who signed their enrollment agreement during the reporting period, were eligible for STRF, and who made their first payment during the reporting period; and

(4) The total number of students who signed their enrollment agreement in a previous reporting period, were eligible for STRF, and who made their first payment during the current reporting period; and

(5) Total amount of institutional charges after rounding each student's institutional charges to the nearest \$1,000, for all eligible STRF students whose STRF assessment was collected in the reporting period; and

(6) Current contact telephone number of the person preparing the form; and

(7) A declaration dated and signed under penalty of perjury by the person preparing the form that the form and any attachments are true and correct.

(d) In the event of a school closure, any collected assessments shall be remitted to the Bureau within seven days following the cessation of instruction.

(e) Submission of all prior reports and assessments required by this section is a condition of renewal.

The Institution has failed to submit STRF Assessment Reporting Form for the following quarters:

• First and Second Quarters of 2019

On March 27, 2019, the Institution was notified via mail at 311 1st Street, San Rafael, CA 94901, that the STRF Assessment Reporting Form for the 1st quarter of 2019 was due. As of August 13, 2019, the Bureau has not received the STRF Assessment Reporting Form from the Institution.

On June 24, 2019, the Institution was notified via mail at 311 1st Street, San Rafael, CA 94901, that the STRF Assessment Reporting Form for the 2nd quarter of 2019 was due. As of August 13, 2019, the Bureau has not received the STRF Assessment Reporting Form from the Institution.

# Order of Abatement:

The Bureau orders that the Institution submit the delinquent STRF Assessment Reporting Forms with the STRF Assessments collected from students for the quarters listed above. The Institution shall also submit the student information to substantiate the data reported on the STRF Assessment Reporting Forms. The information provided shall comply with "Record Keeping Requirements" Pursuant to 5, CCR section 76140.

<u>Reason for modification</u>: New substantive facts were presented at the conference. The Order of Abatement has been satisfied.

	5, CCR Section 74006(a) and (b) - Annual Fee
	(a) An institution's annual fee is due within 30 days of the date on which the institution originally
	receives its approval to operate and each year thereafter on the anniversary of the date of the
	original approval. (b) An institution shall pay its annual fee in addition to any other applicable fees.
	CEC Section 94930.5 (g) - Fee Schedule
	(g) Notwithstanding subdivision (d), effective July 1, 2018, the annual fee for each campus
	described in subparagraphs (A) and (B) of paragraph (1) of subdivision (d) shall be in an amount equal to 0.55 percent of that campus' total gross revenue derived from students in California, but
	not to be less than two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) and not to exceed sixty thousand
	dollars (\$60,000) for each campus.
	CEC Section 94931(b)- Late Payment
	(b) A fee that is not paid on or before the 90th calendar day after the due date for payment of the fee
	shall be subject to a 35 percent late payment penalty fee.

	of August 13, 2019, the Bureau has not received the annual fee from the Institution.
	Order of Abatement:
	The Bureau orders the Institution to submit its annual fee for calendar year 2019 in accordance
	with 5, CCR section 74006(a)(b) and CEC section 94930.5(g). In addition, the Institution must pay
	all late payment penalty fees <u>.</u>
	<b>Reason for modification:</b> New substantive facts were presented at the conference. The Order of
