		<p>certified by the Bureau for Private Post-secondary and Vocational Education (BPPVE).” under the “About Us” tab.</p> <p>The school shall update the website, and submit a link or a print out of the link evidencing correction with school’s response to this NTC along with the last page of this document to the bureau’s NTC analyst.</p>
