(2) Each instructor shall maintain their knowledge by completing continuing education courses in his or her subject area, classroom management or other courses related to teaching.
	The institution did not have an employee policy requiring instructors to complete a minimum number of hours of continuing education each year. The institution did not maintain faculty records showing the instructor completed continuing education requirements in the last year.
	To remedy this violation, the institution shall update each faculty member file with documentation of their completed continuing education courses.
