The catalog contains conflicting refund polices. The "REFUND POLICY AFTER ACCEPTANCE OF ENROLLMENT BY UNIVERSITY" on page 45 of the catalog in not in compliance and conflicts with page 46 "STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL" (which is correct).

To remedy this violation, the institution shall update and submit the catalog to reflect conformity with the cancellation, withdrawal and refund policies identified in CEC 94920.

The catalog correction shall be submitted with the institution's response to the NTC and the last page of this document within the specified time frame.

To remedy this violation, the institution shall update and submit the catalog with the correct language according to 5, CCR 76215 (a) Student Tuition Recovery Fund Disclosures.

- (d) "Graduates available for employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.
- (e) (1) "Graduates employed in the field" means graduates who are gainfully employed in a single position for which the institution represents the program prepares its graduates, beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the period of employment shall begin within six months of the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- (f) "Graduates unavailable for employment" means graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are

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continuing their education at an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.

- (g) "Students available for graduation" means the cohort population minus the number of students unavailable for graduation.
- (h) "Students unavailable for graduation" means students who have died, been incarcerated, or called to active military duty.

The institution's 2013/2014 and 2014/2015 School Performance Fact Sheets failed to include the required definitions.

To remedy this violation, the institution shall update and submit School Performance Fact Sheets with the required definitions.
