If the bureau has granted an institution approval to operate, the institution may indicate that the institution is “licensed” or “licensed to operate,” but may not state or imply either of the following:</p> <p>(1) The institution or its educational programs are endorsed or recommended by the state or by the bureau.</p> <p>(2) The approval to operate indicates that the institution exceeds minimum state standards as set forth in this chapter.</p> <p>The Institution RVT flyer states the institution is approved by the California Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education. However, the flyer does not state approval means compliance with state standards.</p> <p>To remedy this violation, the Institution shall either explain approval to operate means compliance with state standards or replace “approved” with “licensed”.</p> <p>To document compliance the institution shall submit the corrected flyer to the Bureau with the signed declaration.</p>

IMPORTANT COMPLIANCE NOTICE
