1	CEC § 94909 (a)(2) in conjunction with CEC § 94897 (I)	Violation Description: Although page 18 of the institution's 2024-2025 catalog states, "Southern California Seminary is a private institution that is approved by the Bureau", the institution failed to define the term approved by.

		<b>Correction:</b> The institution shall update all enrollment agreements to include the required charges in underlined and capital letters, on the same page in which the student's signature is required, pursuant to CEC § 94911 (c).
9	CEC § 94911 (e)(2) in conjunction with CEC 94919 (c) and 5 CCR § 71750 (c)(1)	Violation Description: The pro-rata refund policy on page 7 of the institution's enrollment agreements, does not comply with CEC § 94919 (c) and 5 CCR § 71750 (c)(1). The Bureau's requires refunds to be calculated based on the number of days or hours in the program. Whereas the institution identifies pro rata refunds are based on the number of full number of weeks completed.
		Correction: The institution shall update the refund policy in all enrollment agreements to comply with CEC 94919 (c) and 5 CCR § 71750 (c)(1), pursuant to CEC § 94911 (e)(2)
10	CEC §94911 (i)(1)	Violation Description: The institution's enrollment agreements failed to contain the required verbatim statement:  "Prior to signing this enrollment agreement, you must be given a catalog or brochure and a School Performance Fact Sheet, which you are encouraged to review prior to signing this agreement. - (2) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, file with the Bureau a written notice of disagreement, specifying the minor violations described in the notice to comply with which the person approved to operate the institution disagrees, and appealing it by requesting an informal office conference. If a written notice of disagreement is not timely filed with the Bureau, the right to appeal is deemed to have been waived.

Pursuant to CEC section 94935(h), failure to comply with the notice to comply will result in the Bureau taking appropriate administrative enforcement action.
