		<b>Correction:</b> The institution shall update its enrolment agreement, to include the line to initial Immediately following the statement required by paragraph (1), pursuant to CEC § 94911 (i)(2).
8	CEC § 94913 (a)(1)	<b>Violation Description:</b> The homepage of the institution's website failed to post the most current catalog.

- (2) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, file with the Bureau a written notice of disagreement, specifying the minor violations described in the notice to comply with which the person approved to operate the institution disagrees, and appealing it by requesting an informal office conference. If a written notice of disagreement is not timely filed with the Bureau, the right to appeal is deemed to have been waived.

Pursuant to CEC section 94935(h), failure to comply with the notice to comply will result in the Bureau taking appropriate administrative enforcement action.
