On March 14, 2019, an informal telephone conference was held in the matter of Citation: Assessment of Fine and Order of Abatement No. 1819133 (Citation) against 360Training .com, Owner of Quickstart Intelligence. In attendance were Yvette Johnson, Enforcement Chief; and Thomas Anderson, Owner.
