Christina Villanueva issues this Citation: Assessment of Fine and Order of Abatement (Citation) in her official capacity as Discipline Manager of the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) of the California Department of Consumer Affairs.

CITATION

A Citation is hereby issued to Self-Healing Research Center, Owner of School for Self-Healing (Institution) located at 2218 48th Avenue, San Francisco, CA 94116 pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 125.9; California Education Code (CEC) section 94936; and Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations (5, CCR) section 75020 for the violations described below.

BACKGROUND

On February 8, 2018, the Bureau received an Enforcement Referral from the Bureau's Compliance Unit (Compliance). The Enforcement Referral was issued due to material violations found during an announced compliance inspection conducted by the Bureau at the Institution on January 10, 2018, at 2218 48th Avenue, San Francisco, CA 94116. The Enforcement Referral alleges material violations of 5, CCR section 74112(m)(1)(2)(9) Uniform Data – Annual Report, Performance Fact Sheet.

VIOLATION

	for at least five years from the last time the data was included in either an Annual Report or a
	Performance Fact Sheet, and shall be provided to the Bureau upon request; and the data for each
	program shall include at a minimum:

- (1) the list of job classifications determined to be considered gainful employment for the educational program;
- (2) student name(s), address, phone number, email address, program completed, program start date, scheduled completion date, and actual completion dates
- (9) the name, email address, phone number, and position or title of the institution's representative who was primarily responsible for obtaining the students' completion, placement, licensing, and salary and wage data, the date that the information was gathered, and copies of notes, letters or emails through which the information was requested and gathered.

On January 10, 2018, an announced compliance inspection was conducted at the Institution. Bureau staff conducted a review of the Institution's School Performance Fact Sheet for each educational program to ensure conformity with minimum requirements of the Education Code and Regulations.

The Institution failed to provide the required data to substantiate the information reported on the School Performance Fact Sheet for the year 2014-2015.

Order of Abatement:

The Bureau orders that the Institution submit all the required supporting data for the year 2014-2015 for all the approved programs in compliance with 5, CCR section 74112(m)(1)(2)(9).

Assessment of Fine

The fine for this violation is \$5,000.00

TOTAL ADMINISTRATIVE FINE DUE: \$5000.00

ASSESSMENT OF A FINE

In accordance with CEC section 94936; and 5, CCR sections 75020 and 75030, the Bureau hereby orders this assessment of fine in the amount of \$5,000.00 for the violations described above. Payment must be made, to the Bureau, within 30 days from the date of service of the Citation.

COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER OF ABATEMENT

In accordance with the provisions of CEC section 94936 and 5, CCR section 75020 the Bureau hereby issues the order(s) of abatement described above. Evidence of compliance with the order(s) of abatement must be submitted, to the Bureau, within 30 days from the date of service of the Citation.

APPEAL OF CITATION

You have the right to contest this Citation through an informal conference with the Bureau; and/or through an administrative hearing in accordance with Chapter 5 (Commencing with Section 11500) of Part 1 of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code.

If you wish to contest this Citation, you must submit the 'Notice of Appeal of Citation – Request for Informal Conference and/or Administrative Hearing' form (enclosed) within <u>30 days</u> from the date of service of the Citation. If you do not request an informal conference and/or an administrative hearing within <u>30 days</u> from the service of the Citation, you will not be able to request one at a later time.

Unless a written request for an informal conference and/or an administrative hearing is signed by you and delivered to the Bureau by **January 4, 2019**, you will be deemed to have waived or forfeited your right to appeal this matter.

EFFECTIVE DATE OF CITATION

If you do not request an informal conference and/or an administrative hearing, this Citation shall become effective on **December 5, 2018.** Payment of the administrative fine and evidence of compliance with the order(s) of abatement shall be due by **January 4, 2019**. Your payment of the administrative fine shall not constitute an admission of the violation(s) charged.

If a hearing is requested, you will not be required to comply with this Citation until 30 days after a final order is entered against you.
