Christina Villanueva issues this Citation: Assessment of Fine and Order of Abatement (Citation) in her official capacity as Discipline Manager for the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) of the California Department of Consumer Affairs.

### CITATION

A Citation is hereby issued to Syed Imran, Owner of Sprintzeal Americas LLC (Institution) located at 304 S. Jones Blvd. #2014, Las Vegas, NV 89107 pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 125.9 and 149; California Education Code (CEC) section 94944; and Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations (5, CCR) section 75020 for the violation(s) described below.

### BACKGROUND

On May 10, 2018, the Bureau received an internal tip alleging the Institution was advertising private post-secondary education courses in California and charging more than \$2,500.

On May 14, 2018, the Bureau searched the Institution's website and confirmed the Institution was advertising private post-secondary education courses charging up to \$4,998 and operating from physical locations in San Francisco, Los Angeles and 65 other cities in California. The Bureau determined the Institution is conducting business as a private postsecondary education institution in California based on the review of the offering of post-secondary education courses on the Institution's website, [www.Sprintzeal.com](http://www.Sprintzeal.com).

VIOLATION(S)

#	Below you will find the California Education Code (CEC) and/or Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations (5, CCR code) section(s) of law you are charged with violating.
1.	<p><b><u>Violation:</u></b> <b>CEC 94886. Approval to Operate Required</b> <i>“Except as exempted in Article 4 (commencing with Section 94874) or in compliance with the transition provisions in Article 2 (commencing with Section 94802), a person shall not open, conduct, or do business as a private postsecondary educational institution in this state without obtaining an approval to operate under this chapter.”</i></p> <p><b>CEC 94817.5. Approved to Operate or Approved</b> <i>“Approved to operate” or “approved” means that an institution has received authorization pursuant to this chapter to offer to the public and to provide postsecondary educational programs.”</i></p> <p><b>CEC 94868. To Offer to the Public</b> <i>“To offer to the public” means to advertise, publicize, solicit, or recruit.”</i></p> <p><b>CEC 94869. To Operate</b> <i>“To operate” means to establish, keep, or maintain any facility or location in this state where, or from which, or through which, postsecondary educational programs are provided.”</i></p> <p>On May 14, 2018, during the course of investigation, Bureau staff discovered that the Institution’s headquarters is in the United States in Las Vegas, Nevada and is operating in physical locations throughout California and charging up to \$4,998.</p> <p>The Institution advertises private post-secondary education courses on its website at <a href="http://www.Sprintzeal.com">www.Sprintzeal.com</a>.</p> <p>Based on the Bureau staff’s investigation, it was determined that the Institution is conducting business in California as a private postsecondary education institution and its headquarters are located at 304 S. Jones Blvd. #2014, Las Vegas, NV 89107. The Institution is not exempt from the provisions of the California Private Postsecondary Act. The Institution advertises private post-secondary education courses charging up to \$4,998 at physical locations in San Francisco, Los Angeles and 65 other cities in California. Examples of training courses in California include a TOGAF 9.1 training starting on September 10, 2018. Sprintzeal is charging \$2695 for this classroom training and it is located at 1215 K Street, 17<sup>th</sup> Floor, Sacramento, CA 95814. The location is operated by a business named Regus which leases office space for short durations. Another training course for ITIL Service Operation charged \$2,598 and was scheduled for May 18, 2018. The course was located at 515 S. Flower St. 36<sup>th</sup> Floor, Los Angeles, CA 90071. This location is also currently owned and leased by Regus. As such, the Institution falls under the definition of a private postsecondary education institution under CEC 94858. As of January 17, 2019, the Institution continues to operate as an unapproved private postsecondary education institution.</p>

**Order of Abatement:**

The Bureau orders that the Institution cease to operate as a private postsecondary educational institution. The Institution must discontinue recruiting or enrolling students and cease all instructional services and advertising in any form or type of media, including the www.Sprintzeal.com Internet web site and any other websites not identified here that are associated with the Institution, until such time as an approval to operate is obtained from the Bureau. The Institution must disconnect all telephone service numbers that are associated with the Institution until such time as an approval to operate is obtained from the Bureau. To comply with the Order of Abatement the Institution must submit a school closure plan to the Bureau pursuant to California Education Code section 94926. The Institution must provide a roster of each student currently enrolled at the Institution. The roster must include the names of the students, their contact information (including phone number, email address, and physical address), the programs in which they are enrolled, the amount paid for the programs.

**Assessment of Fine**

The fine for this violation is \$75,000.00

**TOTAL ADMINISTRATIVE FINE DUE: \$75,000.00**

ASSESSMENT OF A FINE

In accordance with CEC section 94944; and 5, CCR section 75020(b), the Bureau hereby orders this assessment of a fine in the amount of **\$75,000.00** for the violations described above. **Payment must be made, to the Bureau, within 30 days from the date of service of the Citation.**

COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER OF ABATEMENT

In accordance with the provisions of 5, CCR Section 75020 (b) the Bureau hereby issues the order(s) of abatement described above. In accordance with Business and Professions Code Section 149, the Bureau may disconnect any telephone service numbers used by an unapproved Institution. **Evidence of compliance with the order(s) of abatement must be submitted, to the Bureau, within 30 days from the date of service of the Citation.**

APPEAL OF CITATION

You have the right to contest this Citation through an informal conference with the Bureau; and/or through an administrative hearing in accordance with Chapter 5 (Commencing with Section 11500) of Part 1 of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code.

If you wish to contest this Citation, you must submit the 'Notice of Appeal of Citation – Request for Informal Conference and/or Administrative Hearing' form (enclosed) within 30 days from the date of service of the Citation. *If you do not request an informal conference and/or an administrative hearing within 30 days from the service of the Citation, you will not be able to request one at a later time.*

Unless a written request for an informal conference and/or an administrative hearing is signed by you and delivered to the Bureau by **February 16, 2019**, you will be deemed to have waived or forfeited your right to appeal this matter.

EFFECTIVE DATE OF CITATION

If you do not request an informal conference and/or an administrative hearing, this Citation shall become effective on **January 17, 2019**. Payment of the administrative fine and evidence of compliance with the order(s) of abatement shall be due by **February 16, 2019**. Your payment of the administrative fine shall not constitute an admission of the violation(s) charged.

If a hearing is requested, you will not be required to comply with this Citation until 30 days after a final order is entered against you.
