APPEAL OF CITATION INFORMAL CONFERENCE DECISION: CITATION AFFIRMED

On April 3, 2020, an informal telephone conference was held in the matter of Citation: Assessment of Fine and Order of Abatement No. 1920223 (Citation) against University of East-West Medicine, Owner of University of East-West Medicine (Institution). In attendance were Beth Scott, Enforcement Chief, Eric Tao, President, and Huiping Lo, Director of Government Relations.

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code, section 125.9; California Education Code, section 94936; and Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations, section 75020 and section 75040, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) renders the following decision relative to your appeal of the Citation No. 1920223.

It is the decision of the Enforcement Chief that on April 6, 2020, Citation No. 1920223 is <u>affirmed</u> for the following reason(s):

		"(a) A qualifying institution shall collect the assessment from each student in an educational program
		at the time it collects the first payment from or on behalf of the student at or after enrollment. The
		assessment shall be collected for the entire period of enrollment, regardless of whether the student
		pays the institutional charges in increments.
		(b) A qualifying institution shall complete the STRF Assessment Reporting Form (Rev. 2/10) and remit
		it with the STRF assessments collected from students to be received by the Bureau no later than the
		last day of the month following the close of the quarter as follows:
		(1) April 30 for the first quarter,
		(2) July 31 for the second quarter,
		(3) October 31 for the third quarter, and
		(4) January 31 for the fourth quarter. If the due date falls on a Saturday, Sunday or State or federal
		holiday, the due date shall be extended to the next regular business day for the Bureau.
		If the due date falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or State or federal holiday, the due date shall be extended
		to the next regular business day for the Bureau.

(c) The STRF Assessment Reporting Form shall contain the following information:

(1) Total number of students who signed enrollment agreements for educational programs during the reporting period; and

(2) Total number of students eligible for STRF who signed enrollment agreements for educational programs during the reporting period; and

(3) The total number of students who signed their enrollment agreement during the reporting period, were eligible for STRF, and who made their first payment during the reporting period; and

(4) The total number of students who signed their enrollment agreement in a previous reporting period, were eligible for STRF, and who made their first payment during the current reporting period; and

(5) Total amount of institutional charges after rounding each student's institutional charges to the nearest \$1,000, for all eligible STRF students whose STRF assessment was collected in the reporting period; and

(6) Current contact telephone number of the person preparing the form; and

(7) A declaration dated and signed under penalty of perjury by the person preparing the form that the form and any attachments are true and correct.

(d) In the event of a school closure, any collected assessments shall be remitted to the Bureau within seven days following the cessation of instruction.

(e) Submission of all prior reports and assessments required by this section is a condition of renewal."

The Institution has failed to submit STRF Assessment Reporting Forms for the following quarters:

- Fourth Quarter for 2018;
- Third Quarter for 2019

On December 20, 2018, the Institution was notified via mail at, 595 Lawrence Expressway, Sunnyvale, CA, 94085, that the STRF Assessment Reporting Form for the 4th quarter of 2018, was due. As of February 13, 2020, the Bureau has not received the STRF Assessment Reporting Form from the Institution.

On September 19, 2019, the Institution was notified via mail at, 595 Lawrence Expressway, Sunnyvale, CA, 94085, that the STRF Assessment Reporting Form for the 3rd quarter of 2019, was due. As of February 13, 2020, the Bureau has not received the STRF Assessment Reporting Form from the Institution.

Order of Abatement:

The Bureau orders that the Institution submit the delinquent STRF Assessment Reporting Forms with the STRF Assessments collected from students for the quarters listed above. The Institution shall also submit the student information to substantiate the data reported on the STRF Assessment Reporting Form(s). The information provided shall comply with "Record Keeping Requirements" Pursuant to 5, CCR section 76140.

On April 7, 2020, the evidence of compliance for the Order of Abatement was submitted to the Bureau.

APPEAL OF CITATION

You *do not* have the right to request another Informal Conference to appeal this affirmed Citation. If you did not initially request an Administrative Hearing within 30 days from when the original citation was issued, you can no longer request one.

EFFECTIVE DATE OF CITATION AND FINE ASSESSMENT

This affirmed Citation is effective on **April 15, 2020.** The order of abatement and payment are due by **May 15, 2020**.

Failure to abate the violation or to pay the administrative fine within the time allowed is grounds for denial of an application for an approval to operate or discipline. The Bureau will promptly take all appropriate action to enforce the Affirmed Citation and recover the civil penalties prescribed therein or found to be due after a hearing.
