Christina Villanueva issues this Citation: Assessment of Fine and Order of Abatement (Citation) in her official capacity as Discipline Manager of the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) of the California Department of Consumer Affairs.

CITATION

A Citation is hereby issued to Weimar Institute, Owner of Weimar Institute (Institution) located at 20601 West Paoli Lane, Weimar, CA 95736, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 125.9; California Education Code (CEC) sections 94936 and 94932; and Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations (5, CCR) section 75020 for the violations described below.

BACKGROUND

On June 28, 2019, during an unannounced compliance inspection conducted by the Bureau at the Institution located at 20601 West Paoli Lane, Weimar, CA 95736, material violations were identified. The Bureau identified that the Institution is offering and advertising two unapproved programs, Pre-Nursing Program and Licensed Vocational Nursing (LVN) to Registered Nursing (RN) Program. Both of the programs are listed in the school catalog and advertised on the school's website, <http://weimar.edu>. The institution is offering the programs without Bureau approval.

VIOLATION

#	Below you will find the California Education Code (CEC) and/or Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations (5, CCR code) section(s) of law you are charged with violating.
1.	Violation: CEC Section 94893. Authorization Required for Substantive Change If an institution intends to make a substantive change to its approval to operate, the institution shall receive prior authorization from the bureau. Except as provided in subdivision (a) of Section 94896,

	<p>if the institution makes the substantive change without prior bureau authorization, the institution's approval to operate may be suspended or revoked.</p> <p>The Institution failed to obtain Bureau approval prior to offering the Pre-Nursing Program and the LVN to RN Program.</p> <p><u>Order of Abatement:</u> The Bureau orders that the Institution notify the Bureau of any substantive changes by submitting the appropriate notification or application to the Bureau. The Institution must provide the Bureau with a policy or procedure that ensures that the Institution will notify the Bureau of any changes that affect their approval to operate.</p> <p><u>Assessment of Fine</u> The fine for this violation is \$5,000.00</p>

ASSESSMENT OF A FINE

In accordance with CEC section 94936; and 5, CCR sections 75020 and 75030, the Bureau hereby orders this assessment of fine in the amount of **\$5,000.00** for the violations described above. **Payment must be made, to the Bureau, within 30 days from the date of service of the Citation.**

COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER OF ABATEMENT

In accordance with the provisions of CEC section 94936 and 5, CCR section 75020 the Bureau hereby issues the order(s) of abatement described above. **Evidence of compliance with the order(s) of abatement must be submitted, to the Bureau, within 30 days from the date of service of the Citation.**

APPEAL OF CITATION

You have the right to contest this Citation through an informal conference with the Bureau; and/or through an administrative hearing in accordance with Chapter 5 (Commencing with Section 11500) of Part 1 of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code.

If you wish to contest this Citation, you must submit the 'Notice of Appeal of Citation - Request for Informal Conference and/or Administrative Hearing' form (enclosed) within 30 days from the date of service of the Citation. *If you do not request an informal conference and/or an administrative hearing within 30 days from the service of the Citation, you will not be able to request one at a later time.*

Unless a written request for an informal conference and/or an administrative hearing is signed by you and delivered to the Bureau by **March 10, 2019**, you will be deemed to have waived or forfeited your right to appeal this matter.

EFFECTIVE DATE OF CITATION

If you do not request an informal conference and/or an administrative hearing, this Citation shall become effective on **February 8, 2019**. Payment of the administrative fine and evidence of

compliance with the order(s) of abatement shall be due by **March 10, 2019** . Your payment of the administrative fine shall not constitute an admission of the violation(s) charged.

If a hearing is requested, you will not be required to comply with this Citation until 30 days after a final order is entered against you.


