You may cancel your contract with the school <u>without any penalty</u> or obligation. Classroom Courses:

If your notice of cancellation is made through the first day of instruction or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later, the school shall refund 100 percent of the amount paid for institutional charges, less a reasonable deposit or registration fee not to exceed \$150 (nutrition consultant) or \$250 (natural chef) and any late enrollment fees charged (if applicable).

Distance Learning:

If your notice of cancellation is made through the first day of instruction or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later, the school shall refund 100 percent of the amount paid for institutional charges, less a reasonable deposit or registration fee not to exceed \$150) and any late enrollment fees charged (if applicable). After this date, a student will be charged for the first program module (NC 101). Henceforth, cancellation must take place within eight days after the student has access to curriculum materials for the next module(s) from the Student Dashboard; otherwise, tuition the module(s) will not be included in your pro-rated refund. If the institution has sent the first lesson and materials before an effective cancellation notice was received, the institution shall make refund within 45 days after the student's return of materials.

All Students:

A student may withdraw from a program after instruction has started and receive a prorated refund for the unused portion of the tuition if 60% or less of the program has been completed. Any discount applied to the original enrollment will become void upon cancellation. Refunds on materials in resalable condition will be granted if returned within two weeks after the first day of instruction. A 50% refund of the Student Services and Technology Fee will be granted if cancellation occurs within 45 days after the first day of instruction. After that point, the fee will be charged in full.

For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- "Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- "Number of Graduates Taking Exam" is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.

Distance Learning:

After this date, a student will be charged for the first program module (NC 101). All Students:

A student may withdraw from a program after instruction has started and receive a prorated refund for the unused portion of the tuition if 60% or less of the program has been completed.
