If a student cancels enrollment and requests a refund in writing on the first day of class or the seventh day after enrollment; whichever is later; the cost of tuition; less any applicable registration fees will be refunded within 30 days via school check. This policy applies regardless of whether or not the student has actually started training.
- C. For students who cancel enrollment more than seven business days after signing their enrollment agreement but prior to starting classes, all monies paid to the school shall be refunded less any registration fee. (Registration fee is not to exceed \$100.00)
- D. The school's refund policy for students who have completed 60 percent or less of the course shall be a pro rata refund. Any monies due the student shall be refunded within (30) days via school check mailed to last address on file for student.
- E. If the student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of moneys not paid from federal student financial aid program funds.
- F. To withdraw from the school, the student must submit a letter stating the intent to withdraw to the School Director. The Director will arrange an appointment to review the students account and determine the appropriate refund if applicable. Refunds are processed and disbursed from our accounting office within 30 days of processing via company check. Refunds are mailed to last address on file for student.
