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STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

ENROLLMENT CANCELLATION (WITHDRAWAL) - FULL REFUND

Students have the right to cancel their contract for enrollment at Five Branches University and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. To do so they must obtain a Withdrawal form from the Registrar's Office. If they are unable to do so, a letter, e-mail or fax addressed to the Registrar with the Student's signature stating your cancellation of enrollment will be accepted. CHANGE IN ENROLLMENT STATUS – DROPPED COURSE(S)

In order to receive a full refund, Students must cancel their registration for a course one week prior to the course start date. Courses dropped after this date and up until the first class meeting will receive a 50% refund, with the exception of a 1-day course which is non-refundable. Any course dropped after the first class meeting is non-refundable. Students who do not drop or do not show up for a registered course will be charged the full course registration fee.

If a course is cancelled subsequent to a Student's enrollment, and before instruction in the course has begun, the school will make a full refund of all tuition charges. If a course is discontinued after instruction has begun, the school will issue a pro-rated refund or provide completion options for the course. STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

Students have the right to cancel their contract for enrollment (withdraw from the program) at Five Branches University and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh calendar day after enrollment, whichever is later. To do so they must obtain a Withdrawal Form and submit it to the DAOM administrative office within the designated timeframe.
