Actions which are not considered as official notification of withdrawal are: failure to attend class, giving notice to an instructor, stopping payment on a check used to pay fees or verbal notice to any College-Institute office. The effective date of a withdrawal to be used in determining refunds is the date that the registrar receives written notification of withdrawal from the student. Cancellation can only occur when the student provides a written and signed notice of cancellation to the Office of Admissions and Recruitment at the following address:
