STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

You have the right to cancel and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. Each student is obligated to officially withdraw from classes that he/she has enrolled in with an official cancellation form given to the Administration office.
