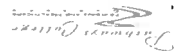

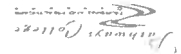

For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- "Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- "Number of Graduates Taking Exam" is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.



- "First Available Exam Date" is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.
- "Passage Rate" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.
- "Number Who Passed First Available Exam" is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.
- "Salary" is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.
- "No Salary Information Reported" is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.

### **"STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL"**

The student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a full refund of charges paid, up to 24 hours prior to the start of the first class session (**ACTUAL DATE:** \_\_\_\_\_)

Cancellation shall occur when you give written notice of cancellation at the address of the School shown on the top of the page of this Agreement. You can do this by mail, hand delivery, or telegram. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with postage prepaid.

The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and however expressed, it is effective if it shows that you no longer wish to be bound by this Agreement. You will be given a "Notice of Cancellation Form" to use at the first day of class, but you can use any written notice that you wish.

If the School has given you any equipment, including books or other materials, you shall return it to the School within 1 day following the date of your notice of cancellation. If you fail to return this equipment, including books, or other materials, in its original condition within the 1 day period, the School may deduct its documented cost for the equipment from any refund that may be due you. Once you pay for the equipment it is yours to keep without further obligation.

If you cancel this Agreement, the school may refund any money that you paid, less any deduction for equipment not timely returned in good condition within 1 day after your notice of cancellation is received.
