STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

Cancellation Policy – All Programs other than Cosmetology and Barbering

Milan Institute advises each student that a notice of cancellation shall be in writing and that Milan Institute shall refund 100 percent of the amount paid for institutional charges., if the notice of cancellation is made through attendance as of the first scheduled class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, defined by means of executing an enrollment agreement whichever is later.
