The Student has the right to cancel this agreement on or before the first day of the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. If the Student exercises the right contained in the immediate preceding sentence, the School shall refund one hundred percent (100%) of the amount paid for institutional charges and enrollment fees. The Student has the right to cancel his/her enrollment from the School at any time during their enrollment by following the Procedures for Cancellation/Termination by the Student. If the Student cancels his/her enrollment from the School after the first day of the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later, the Student will be entitled to refunds in accordance with the Refund Policy.
