Cancellation shall occur when you give written notice of cancellation at the address of the school. You may submit a cancellation notice by mail to the above address or hand delivery. The written cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with postage prepaid. If you attend the first scheduled day of classes, the last day you have to cancel is
Refund Policy If the Enrollment Agreement is cancelled the Academy will refund the student, any money he/she paid, less a registration or administration fee not to exceed \$250.00, and less any deduction for equipment no returned in good condition, within 30 days after the notice of cancellation is received.
After the end of the cancellation period, you also have the right to withdraw from the Academy at any time; and you have the right to receive a pro rata refund if you have completed 60 percent or less of the scheduled days in the period of attendance.
