If you cancel this Enrollment Agreement, the University will refund the amount of tuition that you paid (which does not include the \$100.00 nonrefundable registration fee) within 45 days after your Notice of Cancellation is received by the Admissions Office. For students who participate in the student health plan, a premium in the estimated amount of \$3,200.00 per year is set by the health plan, which is an outside provider, and will <u>not</u> be refunded unless the health plan provides a refund and, if so, then only according to the plan's terms."
