STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

The student shall have the right to cancel an agreement for a program of instruction that is subject of the agreement including any equipment, without any penalty or obligations, through attendance at the first class session or the seventh calendar day after enrollment, whichever is later.

The student can voluntarily terminate from the School by notifying the School in writing at Pima Medical Institute, 111 Campus Way, San Marcos, CA 92078.
