The student has the right to a full refund of all charges if he/she cancels this agreement by submitting a Delancey Street Academy drop or withdrawal form, handed in to the administration office prior to close of business on Monday of the second week of the session.

In addition, the student may withdraw from a course after instruction has started by submitting a drop or withdrawal form and receive a pro-rated refund for the unused portion of the tuition and other refundable charges if the student has completed 60% or less of the instruction.
