STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

<u>New students have the right to cancel the Enrollment Agreement for a program of instruction -</u> <u>including any equipment such as books, materials and supplies or other goods related to the</u> <u>instruction offered in the Agreement - up until midnight of the seventh business day (excluding</u> <u>weekends and holidays) after the first scheduled class.</u>

Cancellation shall occur when a student has given written Notice of Cancellation at the College address shown on the top of the second page of the Enrollment Agreement. A student can do this by U.S. mail, hand delivery, or fax. The written Notice of Cancellation, if sent by U.S. mail, is effective by the postmark date when deposited in the mail properly addressed with postage prepaid.

The written Notice of Cancellation need not take any particular form, and, however expressed, it is effective if it shows that a student no longer wishes to be bound by the Agreement. If the College has provided any equipment, including books or other materials, the student shall return them to the College within 7 days following the date of Notice of Cancellation. If the student fails to return this equipment, including books or other materials, the student fails to return this equipment, including books or other materials, in good condition within the 7-day period, the College may deduct its documented cost for the equipment from any refund that may be due. Once students pay for the equipment, it is theirs to keep without further obligation.

If a student cancels this agreement, the College will refund any monies paid, less any deduction for equipment not timely returned in good condition, within 30 days after Notice of Cancellation is received.
