## STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

A student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund. Any discount applied to the original enrollment will become void upon cancellation. Refunds on materials in resalable condition will be granted if returned within two weeks after the first day of instruction. A 50% refund of the Student Services and Technology Fee will be granted if cancellation occurs within 45 days after the first day of instruction. After that point, the fee will be charged in full. A student is not considered withdrawn until a written cancellation has been received. Cancellation shall occur when a student gives written notice of cancellation at the address of the school shown on the top of the student's enrollment contract. The cancellation notice can be sent by mail, email, or hand delivery. If sent by mail, cancellation is effective when deposited in the mail, properly addressed, and with postage prepaid.

Students who are funded by third-party payers will have any cancellation refund paid directly from Bauman College to the third-party payer, not to the student. Refunds will be processed within 45 days of proper cancellation. Students who wish to cancel must be current with their financial obligations to the school. Tuition charges and fees will continue to accrue until a student's financial account is settled. Should a student wish to re-enroll after a cancellation, Bauman College will review eligibility for the student's readmittance based on the circumstances under which the student canceled. Re-enrollment will only be considered for the same program and must be processed within two years of the student's original enrollment date in order to receive credit for previous coursework.

### **Definitions**

**Number of Students Who Began the Program** means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.

**Students Available for Graduation** is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.

**Number of On-time Graduates** is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.

**On-time Completion Rate** is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.

**150% Graduates** is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).

**150% Completion Rate** is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.

**Graduates Available for Employment** means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.

**Graduates unavailable for employment** means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education at an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.

**Graduates Employed in the Field** means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.

Placement Rate Employed in the Field is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.

**Number of Graduates Taking Exam** is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.

**First Available Exam Date** is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.
