Definitions

- "Number of Students Who Began the Program" means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.
- "Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
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- "Graduates Unavailable for Employment" means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.
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- "First Available Exam Date" is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.
- "Passage Rate" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.
- "Number Who Passed First Available Exam" is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.
- "Salary" is as reported by the graduate or graduate's employer.

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

You have the right to cancel your Enrollment Agreement without obligation, and obtain a refund of charges paid, through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later.

Applicants or students may cancel or terminate their enrollment at any time, before or during their training. Applicants or students should notify an Academic Dean or Campus President of their intent to cancel or withdraw either in person, via telephone, email, or in writing. If you cancel this Agreement within the prescribed time period, the school will refund any money that you paid within 10 days after your notice of cancellation.

If the school has given you any equipment, you must return the equipment within 14 days following the date of the notice of cancellation. If you fail to return the equipment in good condition within this 14-day period, the school may retain that portion of payment paid by you equal to the documented cost of the equipment and shall refund the portion paid by you exceeding the documented cost to the school of the equipment within 10 days after the period within which you are required to return the equipment. Once you have paid for the equipment, it is yours to keep without further obligation.
