STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

Students have the right to cancel your enrollment and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session (less the \$250 registration deposit), or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. To cancel your enrollment, you must submit a written notice of cancelation to the Registrar, Central Baptist Theological Seminary, 6601 Monticello Road, Shawnee, KS 66226.

In addition to your Right to Cancel, you may withdraw from the course after it has started and receive a pro rata refund if you have completed 60% or less of the course. For example: (a) If you completed 2 days of a 5-day course and paid \$2,000 in tuition, you would receive a refund of \$1,200. (b) If you completed the first 5 weeks of a 15-week course and paid \$1,500.00 in tuition, you would receive a refund of \$500.00.

Refunds will be paid within 45 days of the date the seminary receives your cancellation request.

The \$250 registration fee is non-refundable.
