For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- "Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- "Number of Graduates Taking Exam" is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.
- "First Available Exam Date" is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.
- "Passage Rate" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.
- "Number Who Passed First Available Exam" is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.
- "Salary" is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.
- "No Salary Information Reported" is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.

You have the right to cancel this agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day of enrollment, whichever is later.

Cancellations shall occur when you give written notice of cancellation to the main office address of the school shown on the top of the front page of this agreement. You can do this by mail, hand delivery, or telegram. If the written notice of cancelation is sent by mail, it is effective when deposited in the property of addressed with postage prepaid.

The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form, however expressed; it is effective if it shows that you no longer wish to be bound by this agreement. You will be given two notices of cancelation forms to use at the first day of class, but you can use any written notice that you wish.

If the school has given you any equipment, including books or other materials, please note that they are NOT refundable, and will be deducted from your refund. If you cancel this agreement, the School will refund any money that you paid less any deduction for the equipment, handbook, and classes obtained within 45 days after your notice of cancellation is received.
