Definitions

- "Number of Students Who Began the Program" means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.
- "Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
- "Number of On-time Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.
- "On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).
- "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "Graduates Available for Employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.
- "Graduates Unavailable for Employment" means the graduate who, after graduation, dies, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.
- "Graduates employed in the Field" means a graduate who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- "Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- "Number of Graduates Taking Exam" is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.
- "First Available Exam Date" is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.
- "Passage Rate" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.
- "Number Who Passed First Available Exam" is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.
- "Salary" is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.
- "No Salary Information Reported" is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

A student has *seven* (7) *calendar days* after signing an enrollment agreement to cancel their enrollment and receive a full refund of all monies paid. The day by which the student must exercise his or her right to cancel and obtain a full refund of charges paid through transmission of the initial lesson and material, or the seventh day after signing the enrollment agreement, whichever is later is:

After seven (7) calendar days from signing an enrollment agreement the student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through transmission of the initial lesson and material, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. USAELC will refund the student any money he/she paid, less a registration/application and administration fees not to exceed \$250.00, and less any deduction for equipment not returned in good condition. The refund will be issued to the student, and mailed to the student's home address on file, within 30 days of receipt of the notice of cancellation,

After the end of the cancellation periods, students also have the right to withdraw at any time; and the right to receive a pro rata refund if the student has completed 60 percent or less of the period charged (see Refund Policy below).

Student Notification of Cancellation or Withdrawal from a Program

Cancellation /withdrawal occur when the student completes and submits the UNIVERSITY WITHDRAWAL & NOTICE OF CANCELLATION FORM to the Registrar at the following address: USAELC, 2725 Congress St, Suite 2K, San Diego, CA 92110. This can be done by mail, by email to admissions@usaelc.com, or by hand delivery. The form is available from the School's Administrative Office.

The notice, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with proper postage. If the written notice of cancellation/withdrawal is sent by email, it is effective on the day of electronic transmission.
